Location:	Eilat, Red Sea	Visa requirements:	Members of the EU, citizens of the USA, UK, Canada, Australia and New Zealand only need to bring a valid passport. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months.

Included are all meals (with the exception of two dinners which are taken ashore), all drinks whilst on board, cruising permits, fuel, crew, water, port charges, sports and onboard activities and facilities.
Nearest airport:	Eilat, 2 km		*The all-inclusive charge per person will be adjusted annually to reflect the increases in costs of food, drink, labour, port charges and generally the cost of providing facilities on board.
On arrival:	<p>From Eilat airport 5 minutes by taxi, cost approx. Shekels 40. Guests should look out for the Club La Costa Yacht Club representative in the arrivals lounge.</p>	Other useful information:	<p>-You will be asked to complete a check-in form when you arrive and to submit your passports to the captain. Do remember to ask the Captain for your passport when leaving at the end of the journey. This is due to maritime rules & regulations. If you arrive earlier than the specified check-in time you may leave your luggage at the yacht and do some sightseeing or simply relax until boarding. Eilat offers endless opportunities for shopping and leisure. The first evening will be spent at the port, having welcome cocktails followed by dinner on board and a chance to get to know your crew and fellow passengers. Check-in is until 22:00, but any arrivals past 20:00 will not be served dinner. Should your arrival at the airport be after 22:00 you will need to book in to a local hotel and join the yachts for breakfast on Thursday morning. The yacht will leave the marina on Thursday morning after breakfast. Most days there will be a morning and afternoon sail with a stop for lunch in between, and plenty of opportunities for water activities, sunbathing, snorkelling and diving. Each evening we will anchor near the major marinas in the gulf. On Tuesday night we will return to the Eilat marina for dinner ashore at one of the many wonderful restaurants. Weather permitting we will spend some time in the waters of Egypt and Jordan.</p> <p>-There is an age limit of 16 years unless all four cabins on the yacht have been booked for the same party or you have arranged for the yacht to be shared with other families with children.</p> <p>-High factor sunscreen is essential (please refrain from using the spray form and scented oil as it mars the boat and can cause slipping).</p> <p>-Bed linen, bath and beach towels are supplied and will be changed once during the week.</p> <p>-Smoking is only permitted on deck and is not allowed in the cabins or saloon areas.</p> <p>-A library, board games and cards are available on board.</p> <p>-The waters we sail in are generally calm and guests rarely experience seasickness. You may, of course, bring some form of prevention with you, although tablets will be available on board if needed.</p> <p>- It is recommended that you use a credit card in Israel, Egypt and Jordan. ATM's are readily available and credit cards are accepted in most establishments. Where cash is required it is recommended to bring Sterling notes to exchange into local currency.</p> <p>Please note: you will be required to complete personal details and sign a liability form at check-in.</p>
Yacht facilities:	Air conditioned saloon with fully equipped galley and fully-stocked bar (including cocktail blender and ice maker), lounging area, chart table with navigation, plasma screen and DVD player. Dining area. Cockpit with outdoor dining area and lounging seats. Hammocks and outdoor freshwater shower on deck. Stereo with indoor and outdoor speakers.		
Cabin amenities:	Air conditioning, storage space, private shower and electric toilet.		
Water activities:	<p>Equipment is provided for water activities: scuba diving, snorkelling, sea kayaking, wakeboarding, water skiing, sea biscuit, fishing, water mattresses and windsurfing.</p> <p>Scuba diving is only permitted on presentation of full certification and insurance, and a £30 charge per dive will be made to non-Yacht Club Members (payable in local currency, exchange rates may vary according to date of payment). Wetsuits can be rented from a local dive shop - alternatively, guests are welcome to bring their own equipment if preferred.</p>		
Clothing:	The Red Sea enjoys a pleasant year-round climate so for most of the sailing season lightweight casual clothes and beachwear during the day will be the norm. For evenings, please note that heavier and warmer clothing is required as temperatures can drop. Please pack clothes in soft bags and as far as possible keep luggage to a minimum.		
Footwear:	<p>Concerning what shoes to wear while on the Yacht, it is important that you have the proper footwear in order to ensure safety and keep the boat ship-shape. If you have regular boat or deck shoes, these are ideal. However, if you do not, trainers or sports shoes are welcome so long as they are non-marking (no dark soles), have been cleaned prior to being used on board and are only used on board. Barring these options, you will have to get around the boat either in socks or barefoot.</p>		
Voltage:	220v (50Hz) electrical outlets are available on board for hairdryers, electric shavers etc. A converter or adaptor is recommended if your appliance is not compatible with European sockets (2 round pin type).
