

## YACHT INFORMATION SHEET

<b>Nearest airport:</b>	Hurghada, 22 km	<b>Visa requirements:</b>	Members of the EU, citizens of the USA, UK, Canada, Australia and New Zealand only need to bring a valid passport. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months.
<b>On arrival:</b>	<p>Guests will be met at the airport by a Club Yacht Club representative. Transfer to and from the yacht is not included; however guests will be assisted in locating a suitable transport method to the marina.</p>		
<b>Yacht facilities:</b>	<p>Air conditioned saloon with fully equipped galley and fully-stocked bar (including cocktail blender and ice maker), lounging area, chart table with navigation, plasma screen and DVD player. Dining area. Cockpit with outdoor dining area and lounging seats. Hammocks and outdoor freshwater shower on deck. Stereo with indoor and outdoor speakers.</p>		
<b>Cabin amenities:</b>	<p>Air conditioning, storage space, private shower and electric toilet.</p>		
<b>Water activities:</b>	<p>Equipment is provided for water activities: scuba diving, snorkelling, sea kayaking, wakeboarding, water skiing, sea biscuit, fishing, water mattresses and windsurfing.</p> <p>Scuba diving is only permitted on presentation of full certification and insurance, and a £30 charge per dive will be made to non-Yacht Club Members (payable in local currency, exchange rates may vary according to date of payment). Wetsuits can be rented from a local dive shop - alternatively, guests are welcome to bring their own equipment if preferred.</p>		
<b>Clothing:</b>	<p>The Red Sea enjoys a pleasant year-round climate so for most of the sailing season lightweight casual clothes and beachwear during the day will be the norm. For evenings, please note that heavier and warmer clothing is required as temperatures can drop to 10°C - 12°C. Please pack clothes in soft bags and as far as possible keep luggage to a minimum.</p>		
<b>Footwear:</b>	<p><b>While on the yacht it is important that guests have the proper footwear to ensure safety and keep the boat ship-shape. If you have regular boat or deck shoes, these are ideal. However, if you do not, trainers or sports shoes are welcome so long as they are non-marking (no dark soles), have been cleaned prior to being used on board, and are only used on board. Barring these options, guests will be required to get around the boat either in socks or barefoot.</b></p>		
<b>Voltage:</b>	<p>220v (50Hz) electrical outlets are available on board for hairdryers, electric shavers etc. A converter or adaptor is recommended if your appliance is not compatible with European sockets (2 round pin type).</p>		
		<b>All-inclusive fee:</b>	<p>The non-refundable mandatory all-inclusive package price of £510* per person is payable at least two months prior to arrival. Included are all meals (with the exception of two dinners which are taken ashore), all drinks whilst on board, cruising permits, fuel, crew, water, port charges, sports and onboard activities and facilities.</p> <p>*The all-inclusive charge per person may be adjusted annually to reflect the increases in costs of food, drink, labour, port charges and generally the cost of providing facilities on board.</p>
		<b>Other useful information:</b>	<p>-An entry visa is required to enter Egypt. This can either be applied for prior to travel or on arrival. Delays may be incurred at passport control if choosing the latter option.</p> <p>-All guests will be asked to complete a check-in form when you arrive and to submit your passports to the captain. Do remember to ask the Captain for your passport when leaving at the end of the journey. This is due to maritime rules &amp; regulations. If you arrive earlier than the specified check-in time you may leave your luggage at the yacht and do some sightseeing or simply relax until boarding. El Gouna is an exclusive location offering endless opportunities for shopping and leisure. The first evening will be spent at the port (having welcome cocktails followed by dinner on board and a chance to get to know your crew and fellow passengers. Check-in is until 10pm, but any arrivals past 8pm will not be served dinner. The yacht will leave the marina on Saturday morning after breakfast. Most days there will be a morning and afternoon sail with a stop for lunch in between, and plenty of opportunities for water activities, sunbathing, snorkelling and diving. Each evening the yachts will anchor in a secure location. Where possible, one evening will be spent in the marina for guests to enjoy dinner ashore at one of the many wonderful restaurants.</p> <p>-There is an age limit of 16 years unless all four cabins on the yacht have been booked for the same party or you have arranged for the yacht to be shared with other families with children.</p> <p>-High factor sunscreen is essential (please refrain from using the spray form and scented oil as it marks the boat and can cause slipping).</p> <p>-Bed linen, bath and beach towels are supplied and will be changed once during the week.</p> <p>-Smoking is only permitted on deck and is not allowed in the cabins or saloon areas.</p> <p>-A library, board games and cards are available on board.</p> <p>-The waters we sail in are generally calm and guests rarely experience seasickness. You may, of course, bring some form of prevention with you, although tablets will be available on board if needed.</p> <p>-Most restaurants and shops take all recognised credit cards. There will also be ATM's in El Gouna.</p> <p><b>Please note: you will be required to complete personal details and sign a liability form at check-in.</b></p>
