NEAREST AIRPORT

The nearest airport is Athens, 35km.

EMBARKATION/PORT DETAILS/EARLY ARRIVAL LUGGAGE STORAGE

- The boat departs as soon as all guests have arrived. Please be prompt.
- We will provide the port authorities with your personal details in advance, and you will be required to check this detail and sign liability forms at check-in.
- Direct access to the yacht for luggage storage during the preparation period is unavailable. This time is dedicated to preparing the boat for your embarkation. However, the port office provides convenient luggage storage options for early arrivals, allowing you the freedom to explore Athens, have lunch, or sightsee before embarkation.

YACHT & ITINERARY

You will be sailing on one of our two chartered Lagoon 46 catamarans, exploring islands like Aegina, Poros, Hydra, Spetses, and more. The itinerary, will be confirmed a month before the season, is at the captain's discretion and weather dependent. Anchor stops for time ashore and additional recommended activities are available.

SAILING DEPARTURE & DAILY ROUTINE

- The boats will leave the marina at 18:00, and guests will be served welcome cocktails followed by dinner on board, giving you a chance to get to know your crew and fellow passengers.
- Depending on the weather, most days there will be a morning and afternoon sail with a stop for lunch in between, and plenty of opportunities for water activities, exploring the islands and coastline, and maybe some shopping during the day.
- Evening Anchorage:**
 - Each evening, we will anchor in one of the many bays.
- Mid-Week Dining Ashore:**
 - Mid-week, your crew will find a place for you to dine ashore, and a further meal will be taken ashore on your last night.

YACHT FACILITIES

Saloon with fully equipped galley, bar, lounging area and TV fusion audio system. Indoor and outdoor dining area, coffee machine.

CABIN AMENITIES

Air conditioning, storage space, private shower and electric toilet.

WATER ACTIVITIES

- Equipment provided for snorkelling, sea kayaking and paddleboarding.
- Scuba diving can be arranged separately and will be subject to a charge. Should you wish to scuba dive you must advise this at the time of making your reservation and will only be permitted on presentation of full certification and proof of insurance which includes scuba diving.
- Diving will be pre-arranged in advance of sailing with a third party dive company.
- Wetsuits can be hired locally with the dive company. Alternatively, you can bring your own wetsuit and equipment.

CLOTHING

- In the warm Greek summers, lightweight casual attire is suitable for most of the sailing season.
- Yet, during the shoulder months, mornings and evenings might be cooler.
- Prior to your departure, check the online weather forecast.
- Consider packing slightly more elegant attire for your two meals ashore.

FOOTWEAR

- Appropriate footwear is crucial for safety and maintaining the pristine condition of the yacht.
- Ideal choices include standard boat or deck shoes; however, if these are unavailable, clean trainers or sports shoes are acceptable as long as they are non-marking (with no dark soles). Please ensure that such footwear is used exclusively on board.
- Alternatively, if these options are not viable, whilst on the yacht you will be required to either wear socks or bare feet.

VOLTAGE AND ELECTRICAL OUTLETS

- Onboard electrical outlets: 220V (50Hz).
- Adapter requirement: European 2-pin round adapter (220V).

CURRENCY INFORMATION

The official currency is EURO.

However, it is important to note that some restaurants, shops, and smaller hotels may not accept credit cards. In addition, ATMs often dispense larger denomination notes.

ALL-INCLUSIVE PACKAGE FEE

- A non-refundable, mandatory all-inclusive fee is required.
- Payment options: You can choose to pay in two instalments or in full at the time of booking.
- Includes on-board meals, beverages, permits, fuel, crew, water, port charges, sports, and onboard activities.

GUEST INFORMATION, PREFERENCES & ARRIVAL DETAILS FORM

- To enhance your experience, we kindly ask all guests to complete the Guest Information, Preferences, and Arrival Details Form at least 6 weeks before check-in. As the season approaches, we will share the link to this form here on our Members website resort page.
- In addition, we will contact you via email to ensure you have convenient access to the form.

CREW GRATUITIES/TIPS

These are not included, and it is suggested as a guideline: 12-15% of the all-inclusive fee per person.

AGE RESTRICTIONS AND TRAVELLING WITH UNDER 18'S

- There is an age restriction of 16 years of age for passengers unless all four cabins on the Yacht have been booked for the same party or you have arranged for the Yacht to be shared with other families with children.
- Families with children aged 8 years or younger, traveling together or sharing the yacht with other families, are required to pay for an obligatory safety net which has to be installed around the boat prior to their trip.
- Please note this safety net incurs an additional supplementary cost.

BED LINEN AND TOWELS

- Bed linen, towels, and a beach towel are provided for guests. As part of our environmental policy, there is no midweek change of these items to minimize our ecological footprint.

INTERNET ACCESS & WIFI

- Wi-Fi is available on the boat, but the quality of the signal is dependent on your location.
- Please note that downloading large files, such as films and music, may not be possible or could be very slow.
- Therefore, it is advisable to download such files before sailing to ensure a smoother online experience.

SAFETY & HEALTH GUIDELINES

- Please refrain from using spray body lotion/cream, sunscreen, and scented oil for safety reasons, as they can cause slippery decks.
- Smoking is ONLY permitted on deck, and strictly prohibited inside under any circumstances.
- While the Saronic seas are known for their calm waters, it's advisable to bring seasickness prevention remedies if needed. These will also be available on board for your convenience.

TRAVEL RESPONSABILITY: VISAS, PASSPORTS & TRAVEL INSURANCE

- Mandatory travel insurance is required, including scuba diving coverage if this is something you have confirmed prior to sailing.
- Passengers must have valid passports and correct travel documentation.
- Adequate travel insurance is mandatory for the trip, covering all planned activities. **Please note:**
 - Travel-related responsibilities, including obtaining visas, ensuring valid passports, and acquiring adequate travel insurance, are the responsibility of each guest.
 - It is essential to verify and fulfil all necessary travel requirements before embarking on the journey.
